Attendance

Regular attendance at school is essential in order for students to achieve their potential and arriving to school on time is vital for a productive learning environment. The Department of Education Attendance policy states that “Parents are required to explain the absences of their children from school promptly and within seven days to the school.” If an absence is unexplained a phone call or note will be sent home to explain the absence. Absences will be recorded as justified or unjustified. If at any time throughout the school year you are taking extended leave, you will need to contact the school.

Each child who has an attendance rate at or above 95% each term will be recognised at the honours assembly. They will also go into the draw to receive a prize at this assembly. Those that have an attendance rate of 95% or above over the course of the whole year will be recognised at the presentation day assembly as well as go into the draw to receive a prize at this assembly.

Every day counts!

Hints to help your child learn mathematics

Use the language of mathematics and show your children the mathematics that is all around. Ask them to count, read signs, tell you how much an item is at the shop, add and take away things, multiply and divide things. Encourage them to measure out ingredients or count objects.

Every student needs to know their times tables off by heart so encourage your child/children to practise the ones they have learnt every day. Multiplication and division start in Kindergarten with students grouping and sharing collections of objects.

Book Character Parade & Meal Deal

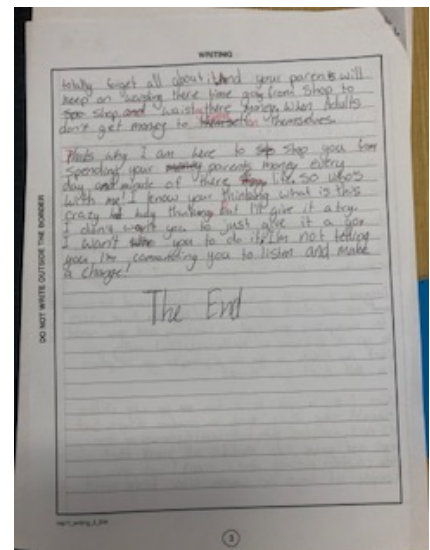
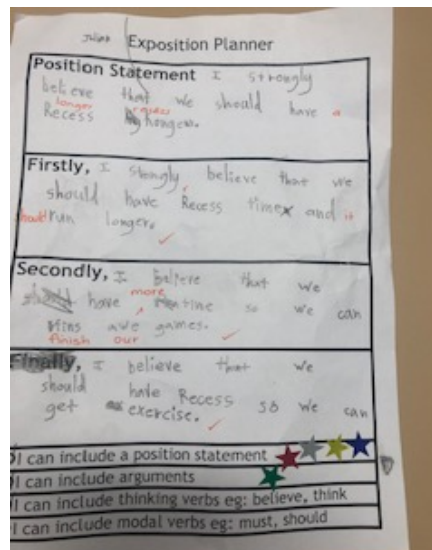
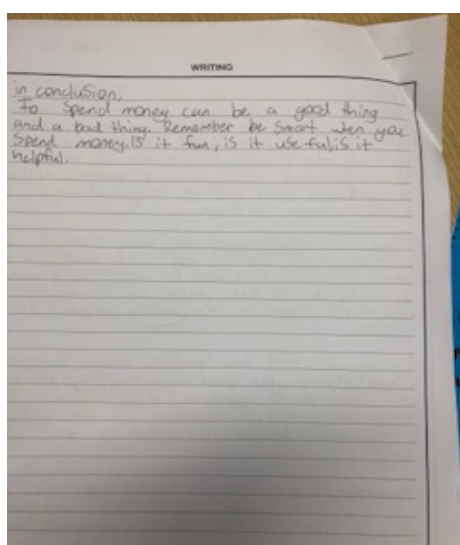
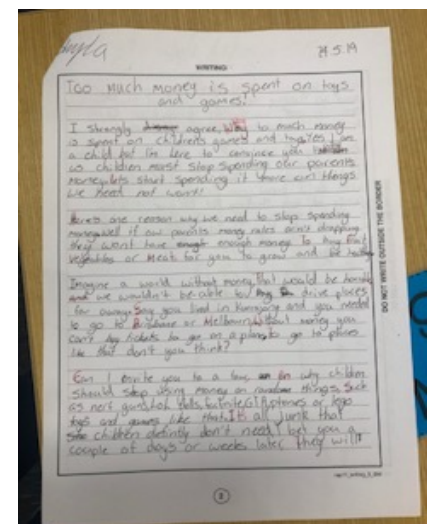
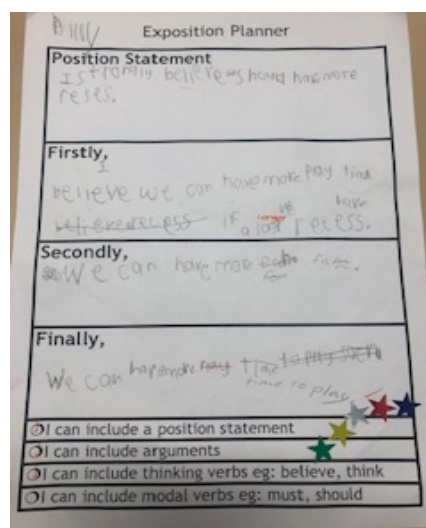
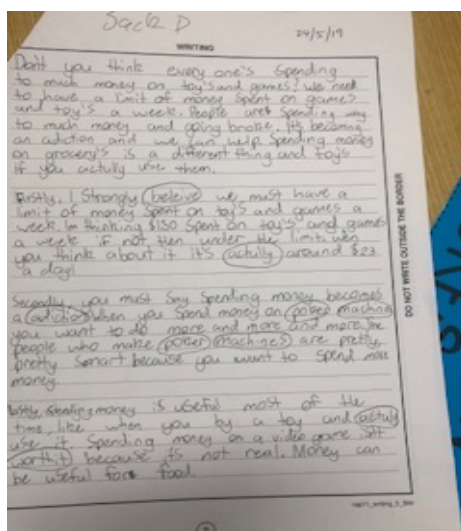
