Staff Professional Learning

On Monday 18 July, all staff attended a full day of professional learning with 15 schools from across the Hawkesbury, Windsor & Ponds networks. The focus for the day was grammar, and teachers had the opportunity to deepen their knowledge and understanding, in order for us to plan for and teach Sentence of the Day, as part of the Morning Routine. Sentence of the Day provides students with daily lessons on grammar and punctuation and supports learning for future writing tasks. All staff had a fantastic day networking with staff from other schools and learnt a lot about the intricacies of the English language. We are looking forward to engaging with further learning this term to deepen our understanding of grammar and utilise this new knowledge to support continued academic success for all students in the Key Learning Area (KLA) of English.

Aboriginal VR Incursion

Our Aboriginal Incursion that was due to take place last term has been rescheduled to Thursday 15 September 2022. All students from Kindergarten to Year 6 will be immersed in an Aboriginal Virtual Reality experience. There is no cost to families for this incursion as the school will cover all costs. This incursion assists cultural learning within our teaching and learning programs across the Key Learning Areas.

Australia's indigenous culture is one of the oldest surviving cultures in the world. The Pamagirri Aboriginal group transport viewers in a full 360-degree view to the Far North Queensland rainforest. The workshop also includes interactive educational games about bush tucker and hunting, as well as an incredible CGI video about the Dreamtime to amaze your child.

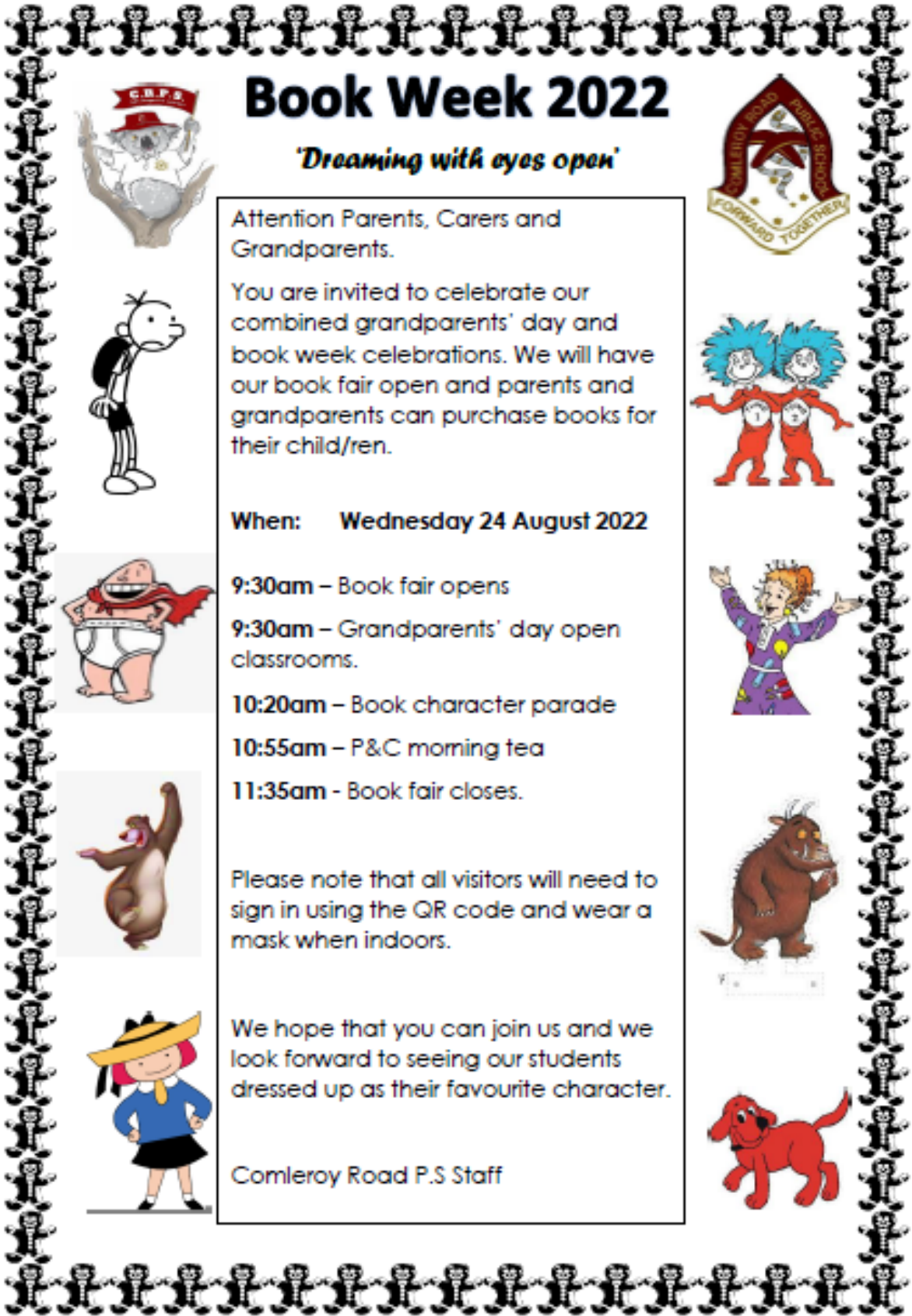

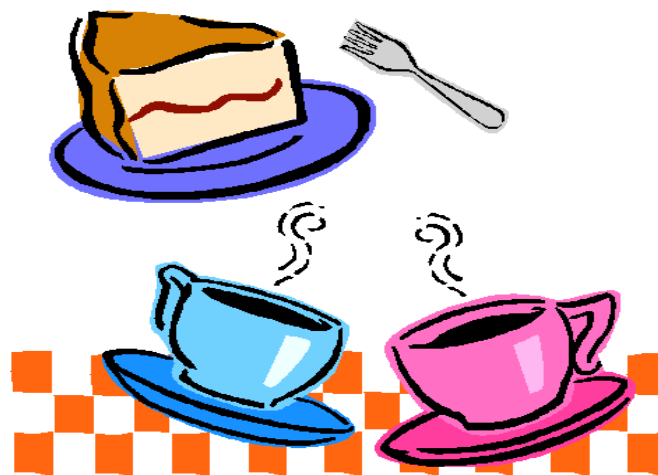
